





MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT 1990 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- 1. On September 26, 1990, the Milwaukee Police Department in conjunction with the Milwaukee Sheriff Department established a Guns hotline (278-GUNS), for the anonymous reporting of firearms violations.
- 2. In November 1990, the Milwaukee Police Department started using, for the first time, Video Camcorders for taping drivers suspected of driving under the influence of intoxicants.
- 3. This year, for the first time ever, Police Department personnel became involved in the recruiting of applicants for the position of police officer.
- 4. On September 30, 1990, the Police Department established a canine unit comprised of six German shepherd dogs and six handlers. The unit assists in narcotics search warrants, building searches for concealed suspects, outdoor searches, and fleeing suspects.
- 5. At the beginning of September 1990, the Police Department initiated a pilot bicycle patrol program utilizing four neighborhood foot patrol (NFP) officers.
- 6. In June of 1990, the Police Department's Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system went into operation.

1991 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- 1. The Chief organized a Firearms Committee to facilitate a change from revolver to semi-automatic pistols. The first stage of replacement is scheduled for 1992.
- 2. A task force designed to "Give Us Neighborhood Safety" or G.U.N.S. was implemented on November 14, 1991. A designated area of the city was targeted for the recovery of guns.
- 3. In May of 1991, a robbery task force was organized. As of October 5, 1991, the task force made 67 arrests for homicide, 398 for robbery, 181 for other violent crimes, and 68 for drug related offenses.
- 4. A program was initiated in early summer of 1991 to promote district station cleanliness. An award was established for the district station judged to have the best appearance.
- 5. On October 19, 1991, the Department created a program called "Catch Auto Thieves" or "C.A.T." Citizens who elect to participate are given stickers to affix on their vehicles which authorize the police to stop their auto at designated times of the day when the owner most likely would not be driving his vehicle.

POLICE RECRUITING

In 1990, the Milwaukee Police Department, for the first time in it's history became actively involved in the recruitment of potential candidates for employment. This exiting new era began with the presentation of two community recruitment meetings which resulted in nearly 300 individuals applying for the position of police officer.

In January, 1991 the Recruiting - Background Investigation Division was established in the Milwaukee Police Department. Members of the Recruiting Division made 188 formal recruiting presentations to various schools, colleges, churches, and community groups throughout the City. As a result of these recruiting presentations, police department recruiters received and processed over 1,200 formal applications for the position of police officer and police aide during 1991.

On September 30, 1990, the Police Department established a canine unit comprised of six German sheperd dogs and six handlers. The unit will assist in narcotics search warrants, building searches for concealed suspects, outdoor searches, fleeing suspects, and tracking of missing persons.

CATCH AUTO THIEVES

On October 19, 1991, the Department announced the implementation of a program called "Catch Auto Thieves" or "C.A.T." Citizens who elect to participate in the program place three reflective stickers in the back and rear side windows of their vehicles and give consent to having their autos stopped anytime between the hours of 1 AM and 5 AM. The program has proven very effective in other cities in both apprehending auto thieves and recovering stolen autos quickly.

In 1991, the department's Police Athletic League known as "PAL", continued to grow in the number of kids reached and the number of volunteer officers involved. What makes Milwaukee's PAL program so unique among the 500 cities with PAL is that our officers serve strictly on a volunteer basis.

Our volunteer officers had contact with over 1,250 kids in 1991, at over 40 sites city wide. The officers coached boys and girls under the age of fifteen in

basketball, volley-ball and softball. More importantly, these officers acted as true 'Role Models' for many of these young boys and girls. The kids learned that the Police Officer is their friend and someone they can count on in today's society.
